Domestic Partner Agreement

A “domestic partner” and a “domestic partnership” is defined by the following characteristics:

1. Older than 18 years of age;
2. The partners share a close personal relationship and are responsible for each other’s common welfare;
3. Are each other’s sole domestic partner;
4. Are not legally married nor have had another domestic partner within the previous six months;
5. Have shared the same regular and permanent residence for the last six months; and
6. Have a joint financial responsibility for “basic living expenses” defined as the cost of food, shelter and medical expenses.

If the conditions noted above are met than a domestic partnership exists and the domestic partner and any dependent children are given the opportunity to receive any benefits that would be provided to a spouse or child of an employee for the College.

The following form should be completed and given to the Human Resources Office.
