1. Foundation Skills Requirement

A. Written Communication

B. Oral Communication

C. Mathematics

D. Health/Wellness/Fitness

One or more courses totaling at least 3 credits

Courses used to fulfill foundation skills requirements may not be used to fulfill distribution requirements.

2. Distribution Requirements

A. Arts & Letters

Minimum of 3 courses chosen from at least two disciplines. 1 of the 3 courses will be satisfied by course recommendations listed

B. Social Sciences

Minimum of 4 courses from at least two disciplines. These will be satisfied by course recommendations listed.

C. Science/Math

Minimum of 4 courses from at least two disciplines (3 courses must be in Sciences with Laboratories). 1 of the 4 courses will be satisfied by course recommendations listed

3. Institutional Requirements & Electives

* A “C-”or better is needed to satisfy all requirements

*One course that fulfills the Cultural Literacy (CL) requirement

*No more than 12 career technical or professional technical credits

*Sufficient college level credits (classes with course numbers of 100 or above) to total at least 90 credits, including foundation skills, distribution requirements and a minimum of 35 credits of electives or departmental requirements.

EXAMPLE: Math 105 is included in college level credit total, Math 060 is not included in college level credit total

*Cumulative 2.00 grade point average

*Oregon universities generally require two years of one foreign language in high school, or two terms of one foreign language in college for admittance
