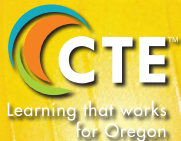

**EARLY INTERVENTION**  
*(15 credits)*

The required courses for earning the Early Intervention CPCC include initial child development concepts that are embedded in the in the Early Childhood Education AAS degree. These courses provide education experiences and training in the areas of Child Neglect and Abuse; Children of Incarcerated Parents; Homeless Children; and Critical Factors in Parent Neglect.

The Career Pathways Certificate of Completion is awarded to students fulfilling the following requirements.
