

Finding MAC Addresses for Common Devices

Windows 10 PC

1. Click the start button
2. Click on the settings gear icon
3. Click 'Network & Internet'
4. Click on 'Wi-Fi'
5. Click Hardware Properties
6. Your MAC address will be displayed next to 'Physical address (MAC):'

Mac OS X

1. Select 'System Preferences' from the Apple menu
2. Click 'Network'
3. Choose 'Wi-Fi'
4. Click on 'Advanced'
5. Select the 'Hardware' tab
6. Your MAC address will be displayed

Android Phone / Tablet

7. Open the Settings App
8. Choose 'About tablet'
9. Choose 'Status'
10. Your MAC address will be displayed next to Wi-Fi MAC address

Apple iPhone / iPad

1. Open the Settings App
2. Select 'General'
3. Select 'About'
4. Your MAC address will be displayed next to Wi-Fi Address

Xbox One

1. Press the menu button
2. Select the gear icon for 'Settings'
3. Choose 'Network'
4. Choose 'Advanced Settings'
5. Your MAC address is listed next to 'Wireless MAC'

PlayStation 4

1. Go to settings on the dashboard
2. Select 'Network'
3. Select 'View Connection Status'
4. Your MAC address is listed next to MAC Address (Wi-Fi)

Nintendo Switch

1. From the Home menu, highlight and select the System Settings Icon
2. Select 'Internet Settings'
3. Tap 'Other Information'
4. Tap 'Confirm MAC Address'
5. Your MAC address will be displayed on the screen
