PAYMENTS & REFUNDS: Full payment is expected upon registration or payment plans are available through CASHNet via MyTVCC Student Portal. Financial Aid is available for those who qualify. Refunds for dropped classes may be offered according to the academic calendar published at www.tvcc.cc/academics. **Students are responsible for all institutional charges if attendance ceases without completing an official drop or withdrawal.**

TUITION AND FEE REFUNDS:

*Refunds of tuition charges and refundable fees resulting from a class drop or withdrawal will be issued at the rate of 100% during the first two weeks of the term (Fall, Winter, Spring), 0% thereafter.

*For the Summer quarter, a 100% refund is available during the first week of the term.

STUDENT HOUSING REFUNDS:

Upon proper and complete withdrawal from student housing and official termination of the contract, the percentages of the total room and board charges refunded are:

*Before the first day of class & occupancy - 100% Refund

*After the first day of class & occupancy - 50% Refund

*After the 10th day of class & occupancy - NO REFUND

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RETURN OF FEDERAL FUNDS/REPAYMENT POLICY FOR FINANCIAL AID RECIPIENTS:

Federal law governs the return of federal (Title IV) funds disbursed to a student who completely withdraws from the institution or stops attending all classes during a term without formally withdrawing (please refer to the college withdrawal policy). If the student withdraws within the first 60% of the enrollment period, funds are "earned" in proportion to the length of time he or she remains enrolled. Students withdrawing after the first 60% of the term are considered to have earned 100% of funds disbursed. For students who withdraw within the first 60% of the term, federal funds are returned in the following order:

*Stafford Loans (unsubsidized then subsidized)

*PLUS Loan

*Pell Grant

*Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant (SEOG)

*Oregon Opportunity Grant (if LEAP funds are included)
