## **EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES:**

- EMT students are finalizing their course work and 8 of 13 students have registered to take their licensing exam in late April.
- TVCC launched a Community Healthcare Worker course with COCC in Spring 2025.
- TVCC is building new Career Pathways Certificates for students interested in alternatives to the 1-year certificate.

#### **BACHELORS OF SCIENCE IN NURSING (BSN):**

 The BSN program and curriculum received final approval from HECC. TVCC is working on the application to Northwest Commission on Colleges & Universities (NWCCU)



- The expected launch is Fall 2026 and each college in the cooperative will be accepting 7 students for this first year launch.
- Applicants simply need to have received their Associates Degree in Nursing (ADN) prior to program entry, then obtain their RN licensure within the first quarter of attendance.

#### **GENERAL:**

- Construction has officially started on the Evelyn S. Dame Nursing & Allied Health Professions Center. Drive by campus, to see a large fence and big equipment making progress on the building. It is projected that construction will be complete by Winter 2026.
- HEA 101— Healthcare Seminar will launch in Fall 2025 as a freshman orientation class focused on introducing students to the Nursing & Allied Health programs that TVCC currently offers to help guide students to a successful educational and career path.
- The Workforce Ready Grant has more than tripled the number of students served based on the application projections. The original intent was to serve 20 students per year and in 5 quarters, TVCC has assisted 77 students.
- TVCC is re-branding to strengthen identity and better serve students and the community. This effort will take place in multiple phases and new materials can be expected starting in Fall 2025.
