

BP 2745 Board of Education Self-Evaluation

There is no Oregon statutory requirement.

The Board of Education is committed to assessing its own performance as follows:

- 1. Conduct an annual evaluation of the Board's performance in providing leadership to the college community.
- 2. Identify its strengths and
- 3. Identify areas in need of improvement.

To that end, the Board of Education has established the following processes:

The process for evaluation shall be approved by the Board of Education.

The criteria for the Board of Education's self-evaluation shall also include performance goals and objectives related to TVCC and the Board's commitment to mission fulfillment.

All Board of Education members will be asked to complete the evaluation and submit it to the Board of Education Secretary.

A summary of the evaluations will be presented and discussed at a Board of Education session scheduled for that purpose. The results will be used to identify accomplishments in the past year and goals for the following year.
