

BP 3540 Sexual and Other Assaults on Campus

Any sexual assault or physical abuse or domestic violence, including, but not limited to rape as defined by State law, whether committed by an employee, student, or member of the public, that occurs on **Treasure Valley Community College** property, is a violation of college policies and procedures, and is subject to all applicable punishment, including criminal procedures, and employee or student discipline procedures consistent with State and federal law. Students, and employees who may be victims of sexual and other assaults and domestic violence shall be treated with dignity and provided comprehensive assistance.

The **College President** shall establish administrative procedures that ensure that students and employees who are victims of sexual and other assaults and domestic violence receive appropriate information and treatment. The **College** will make educational information about preventing sexual violence is widely available on campus.

The procedures shall meet the criteria contained in 34 Code of Federal Regulations Part 668.46 and ORS 350.331.
