The campus security officers shall cooperate with local law enforcement.

The Vice President of Administrative Services shall oversee and issue such other procedures as may be necessary for the administration of the campus security officers, which includes, but is not limited to:

- A. Schedules and shifts – Establishment and adherence to assigned work schedules and shifts.
- B. Call-back procedures – Protocols for notifying and reporting for duty outside regular hours.
- C. Use of vehicles – Authorized use, maintenance, and operational procedures for departmental vehicles.
- D. Weapons practices – Safe handling, training, and authorized use of firearms, including drawing and discharge protocols.
- E. Pursuit practices – Guidelines and safety standards for vehicle or foot pursuits.
- F. Discipline procedures – Steps and standards for addressing misconduct or policy violations.
- G. Training requirements – Mandatory training programs, certifications, and continuing education.
- H. Coordination with local law enforcement – Responsibilities for collaboration and communication with local law enforcement agencies.
