Significant Lapse of Time

Some programs may require coursework to be completed within a specified amount of time for completion

- Pre-Nursing students must have completed Anatomy & Physiology and Microbiology (with in-person lab) within 5 years of applying to nursing school.
- Medical Assistant course work must be completed within 3 years for degree confirmation.

Course Repetition

Courses in music performance, special studies art course, Cooperative Work Experience, and Health and Physical Education activity classes may be repeated for credit.

The grades and credits for such courses will be recorded on the transcript and totaled cumulatively. In some cases, there may be a limit to the total number of credits allowed from those courses when used toward a certificate or degree. There is no limit to the number of courses a student may repeat.

If students wish to use the grade repeat policy for music performance, special studies art course, Cooperative Work Experience, and Health and Physical Education activity classes, they must complete a student petition and submit it to the Registrar's office; the course repeat policy will automatically apply to all other coursework.
