

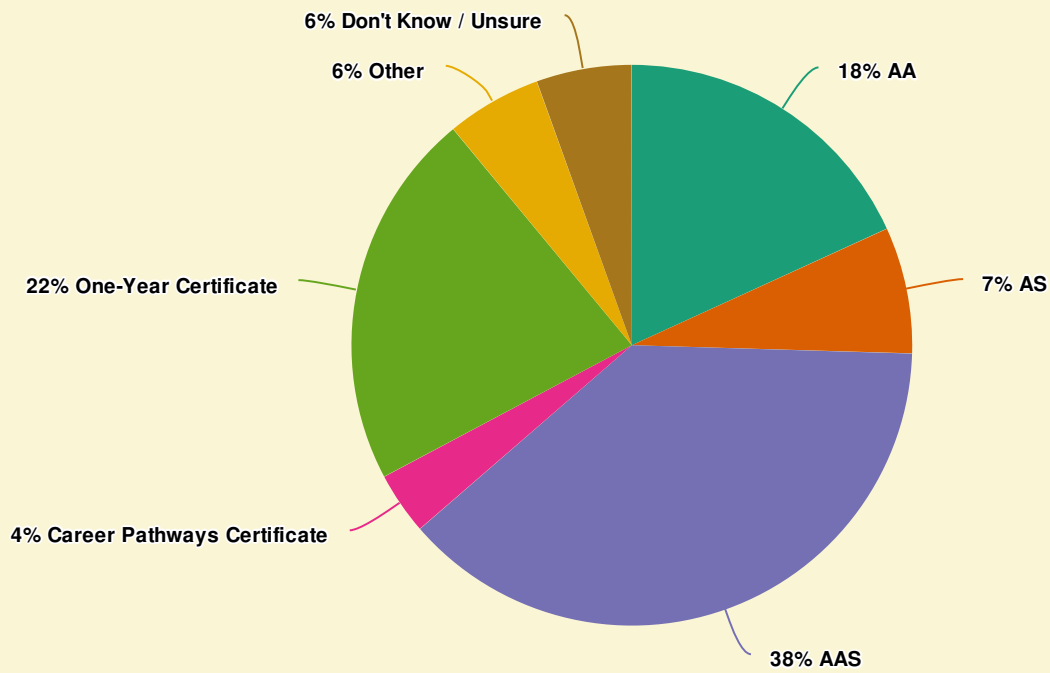

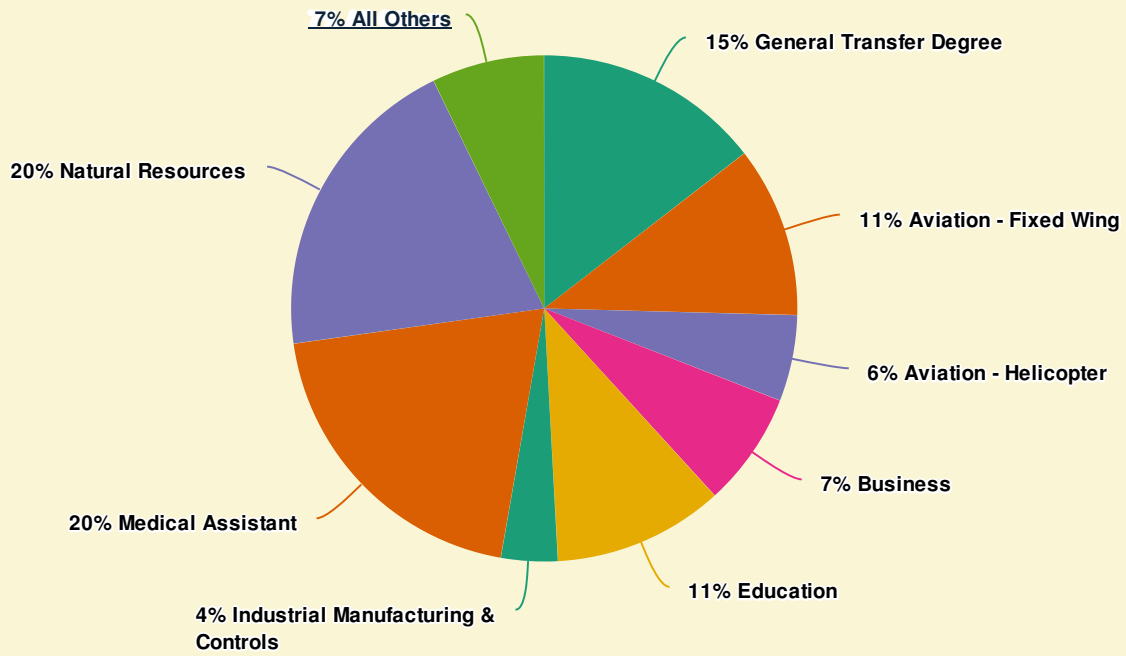
1. What degree or certificate were you pursuing at TVCC? (choose the best option)

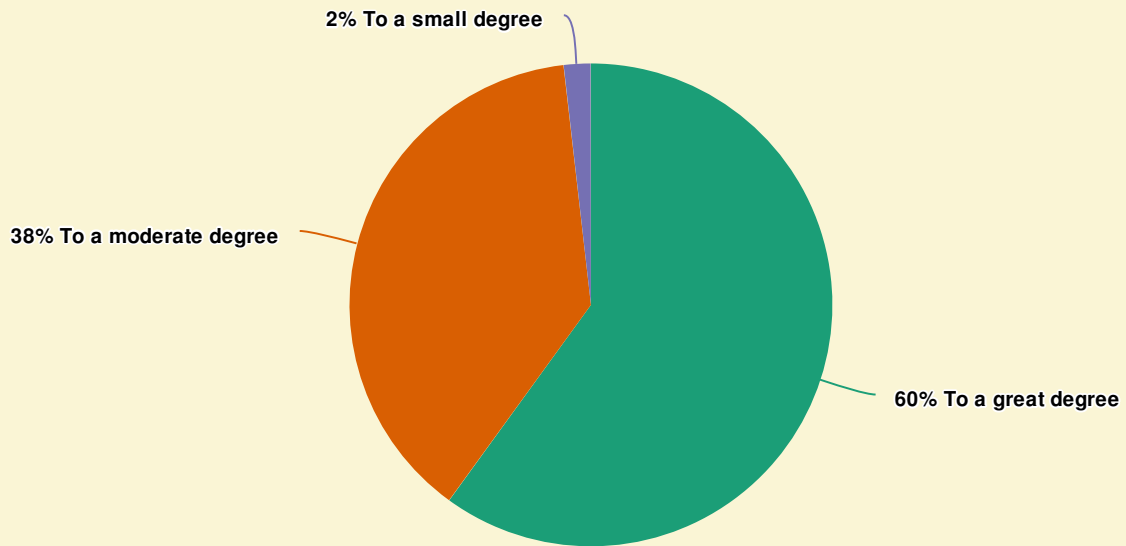

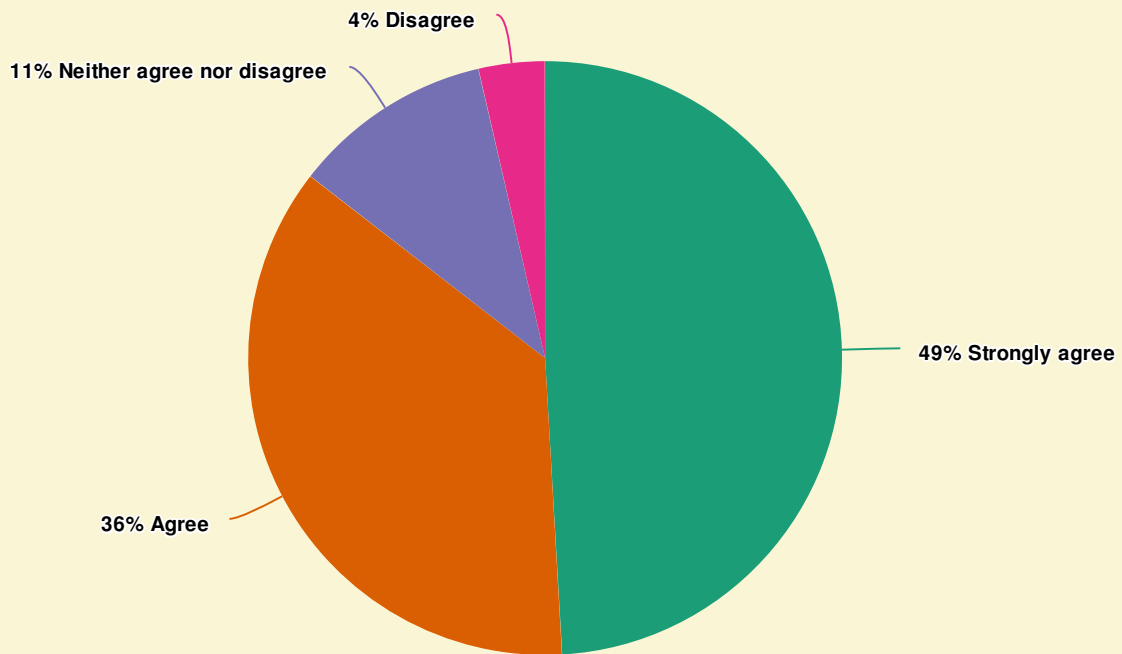
3. In your opinion to what degree did you achieve your degree or certificate program learning outcomes:

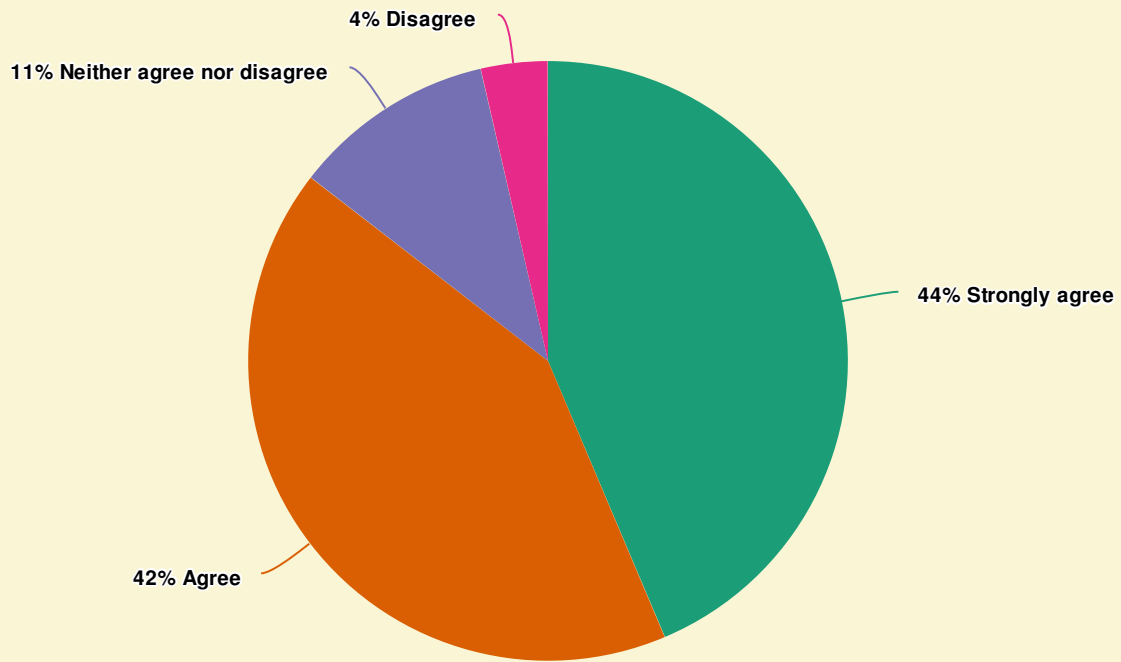
4. My overall experience at TVCC has contributed to my knowledge, skills, and abilities to solve problems using technology and the analysis, interpretation, and application of information.

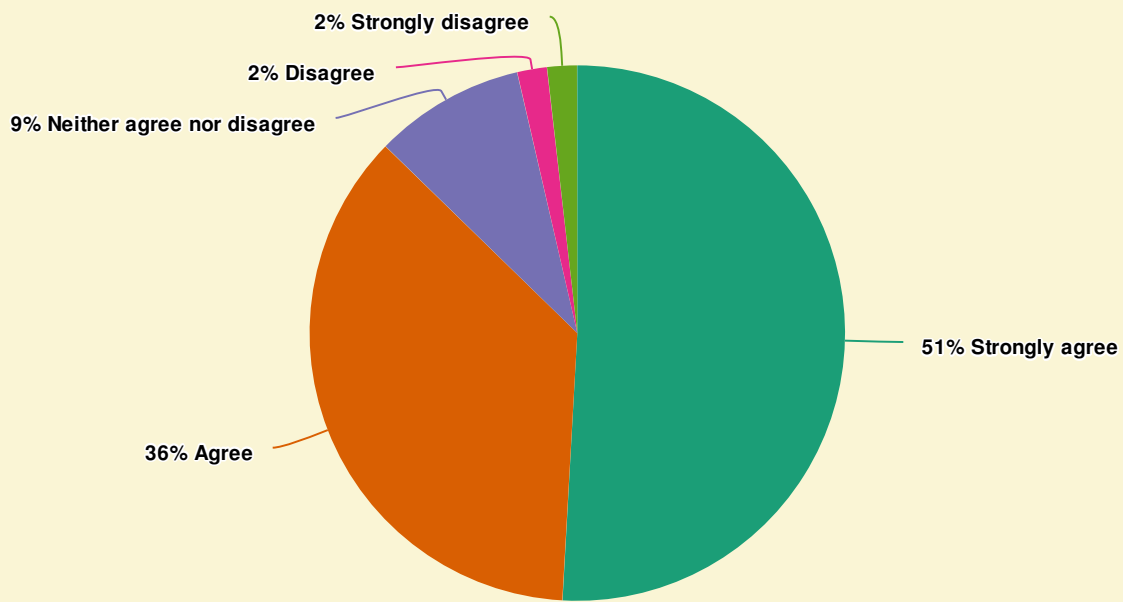

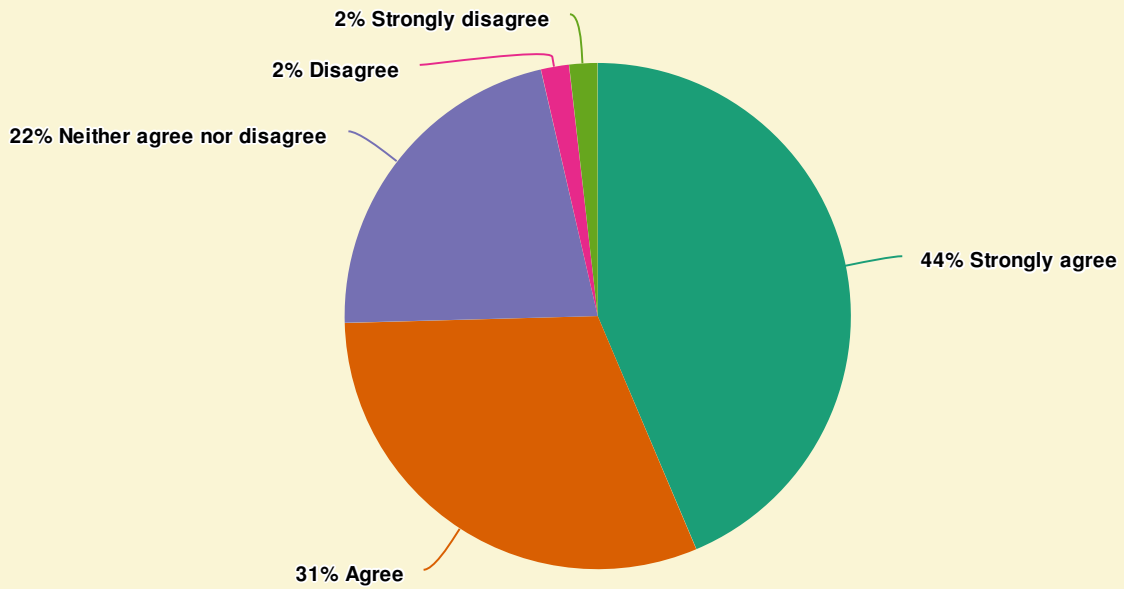

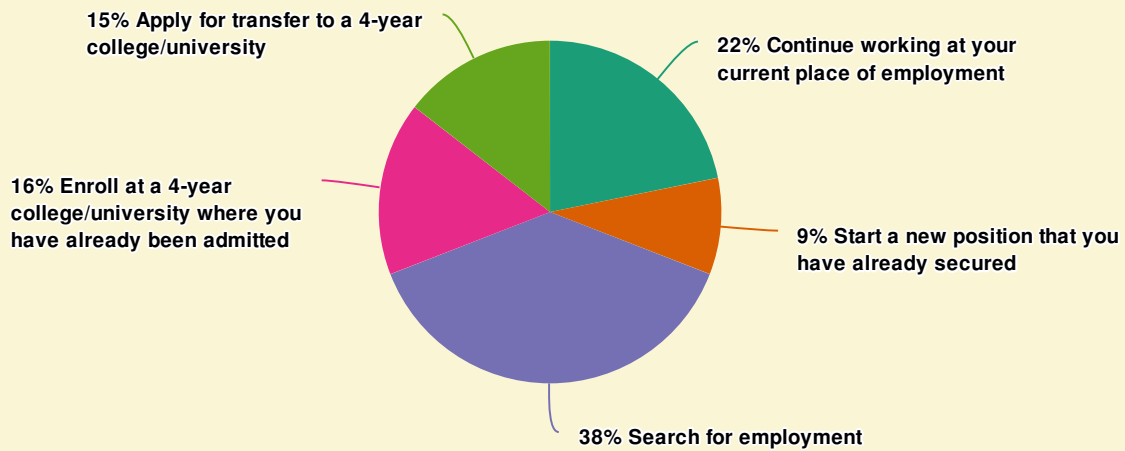

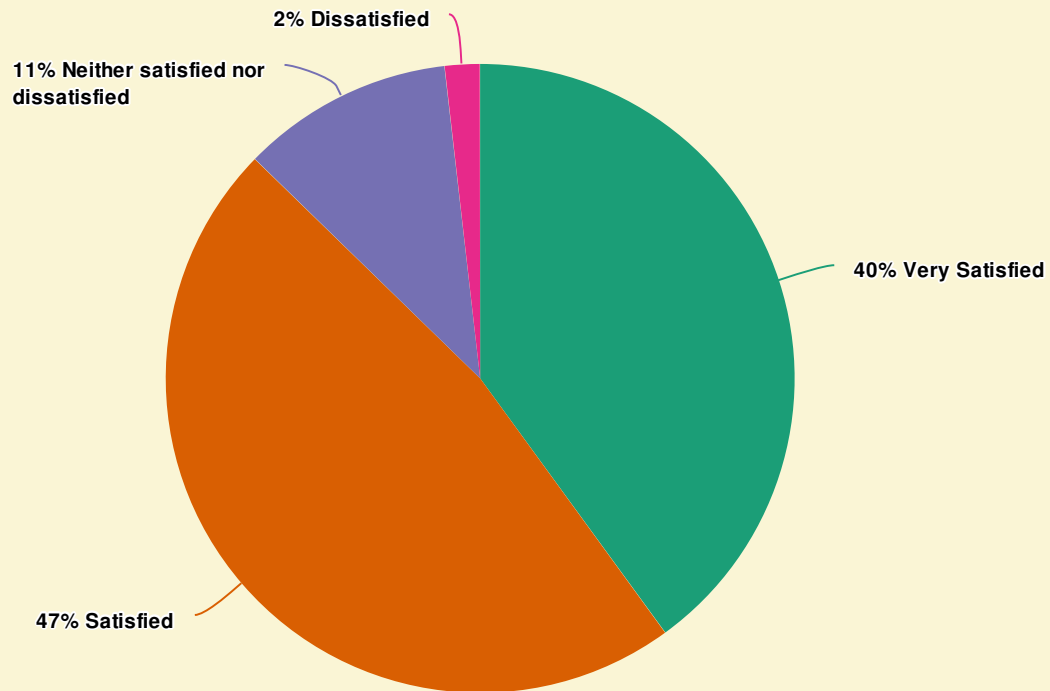
8. What is most likely to be your principal activity upon graduation?

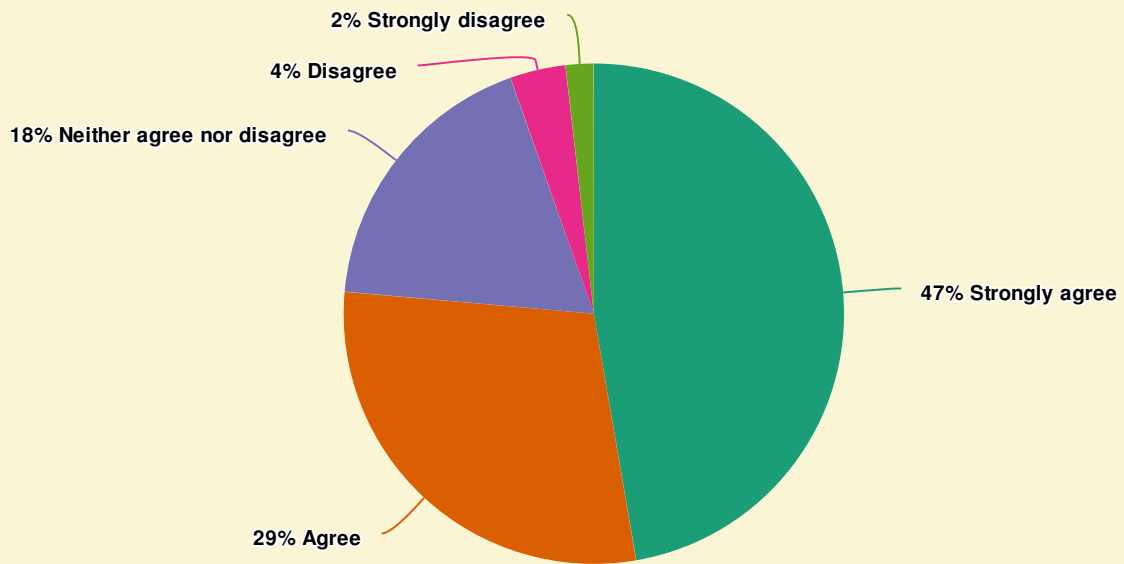
9. How satisfied are you with your overall experience at TVCC?

72 Help students like my situation (refugee) to get more experience in their field.

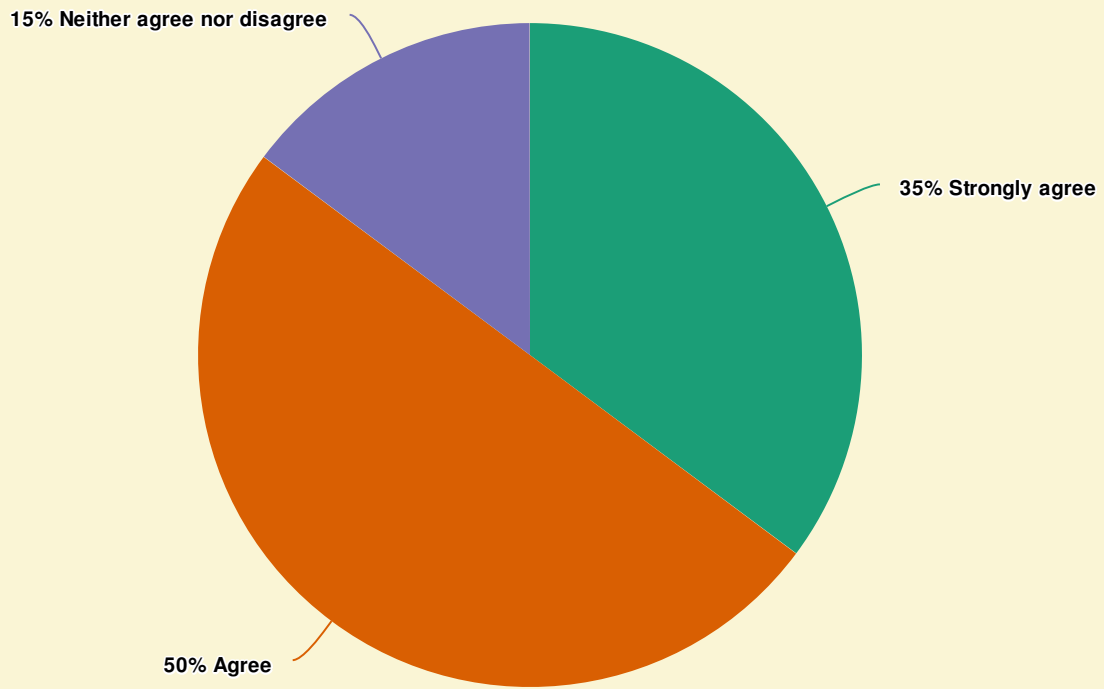

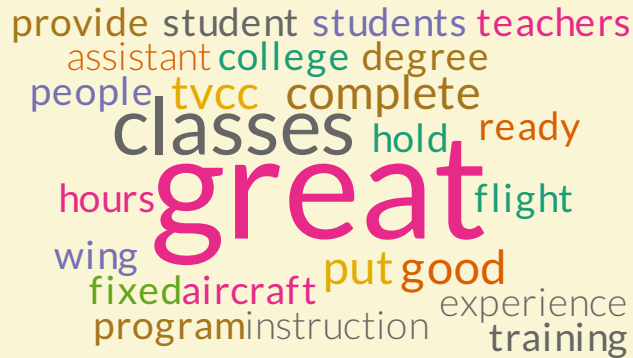

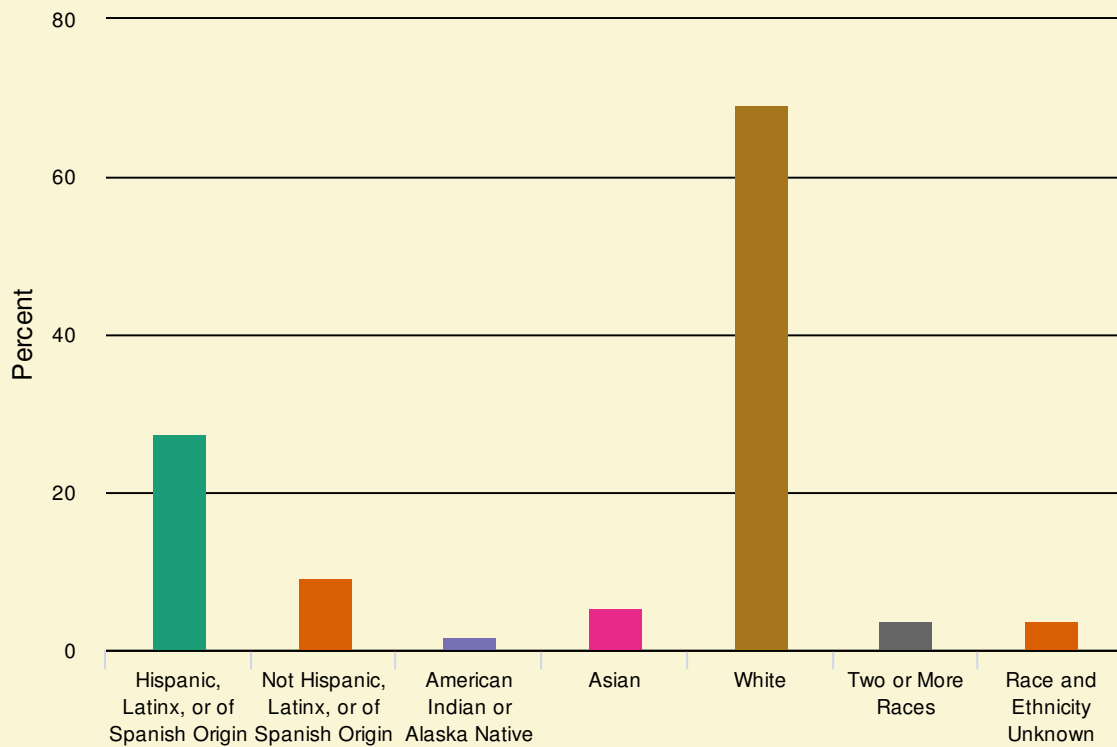
15. Please tell us your gender.

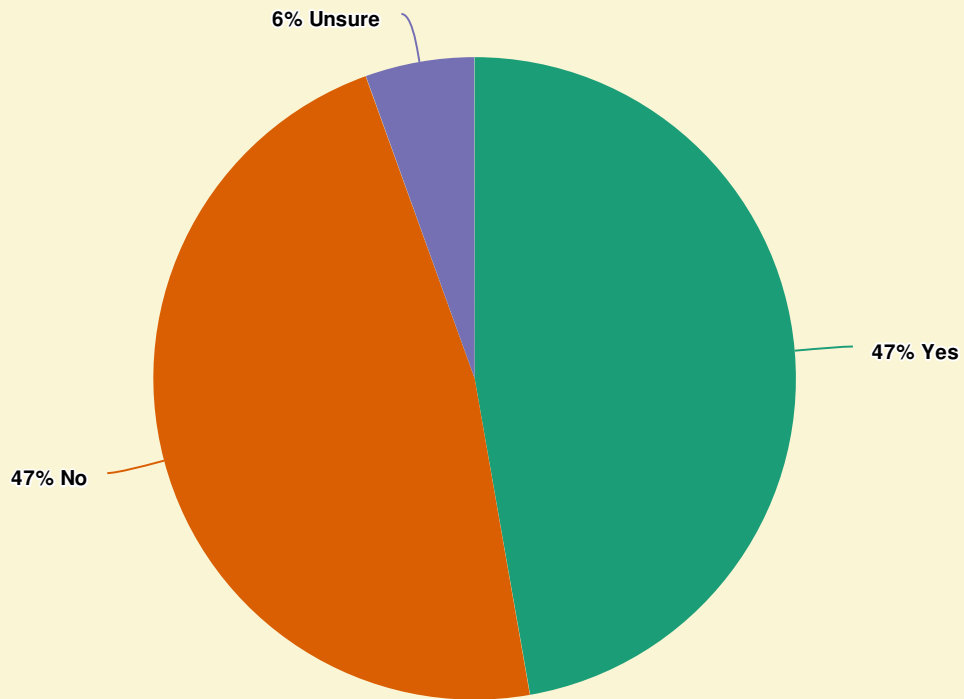

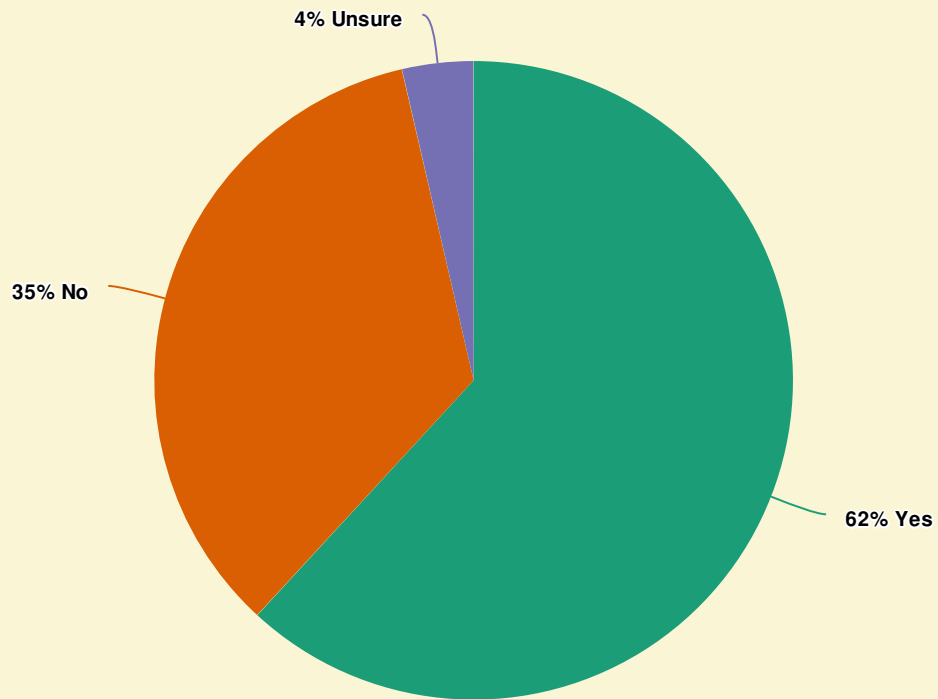
17. Have either of your parents attended at least some college?
